HORTICULTURE PORTAL

The Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops has been doing enormous amount of work since the past many years and continuing to do so for the welfare of the farming community. The dissemination of information is mostly through the little extension machinery that we have. While all other Government Departments have their own website, the Horticulture Department did not have one. Also most of the activities of this Department are amenable to computerization. Hence a comprehensive portal has been developed at a cost of **Rs. 11.00 Lakhs** through NIC, Chennai that will enable the Department to do the following activities online.

1. Allocation of budget online to all the districts, farms, parks and gardens.
2. Disseminate information to the Department staff and the general public and Farmers.
3. The Horticulture portal is bilingual.
4. It has the Citizen centric interface that will enable the citizen/farmer to access the services online.
5. It contains a huge amount of information on Horticulture with links to important scientific institutions in Tamil Nadu, within India and abroad.
6. It enables the Department to converge all its e-Governance activities in one forum www.tnhorticulture.tn.gov.in.
