ORDER:-

In the Government Order read above, the Government accorded an administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.592.807 lakhs for 2010-11 to 2012-13 and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.386.526 lakhs for the implementation of the Horticulture components of activities in 4034 hectares under TN IAMWARM Project in Phase IV, 5 sub-basins.

2. The World Bank has approved a total Detailed Project Report cost (5 years) of Phase I (9 sub basins) for Rs.2819.640 lakhs. Out of the above 9 sub-basins in Phase I, 6 sub basins have already completed the activities and only 3 sub-basins have programmed.

3. The Commissioner of Horticulture and Plantation Crops has proposed to implement the Horticulture components of activities in 333 hectares under TN IAMWARM Project at a cost of Rs.95.16 lakhs and by adopting as per existing National Horticulture Mission subsidy norms during the financial year 2011-12 in Phase I (3 sub basins) including Head quarters IAMWARM Cell which has since been approved by the Empowered Committee.

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4. The Government after careful examination and based on the decision of the Empowered Committee, accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Horticulture and Plantation Crops and accord Administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.95.16 lakhs (Rupees Ninety five lakhs and sixteen thousand only) for the implementation of the Horticulture Components of activities in 333 Hectares under TN IAMWARM Project by adopting existing subsidy norms, during the financial year 2011-12 in Phase I (3 sub-basins) including Headquarters IAMWARM Cell as detailed in the Annexures I, II & III to this order.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited under the following head of account under the detailed / sub - detailed heads mentioned in Annexure - II.

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.2.00 lakhs (Rupees one lakhs under 2401 00 119 PB 7603, Rs.0.50 lakhs under 2401 00 119 PC 7603, Rs.0.50 lakhs under 2401 00 119 PD 0505) will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2011-12. Pending provision of such funds, the Commissioner of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to draw and disburse the amount and requested to include the above additional amount while sending proposal in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2011-12 to Government in Finance (Agri.) Department.

7. The Commissioner of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to make an evaluation study in home on the subsidy scheme for the crops through Department of Evaluation and Applied Research and send a report to Government at the earliest.

8. The Commissioner of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to maintain a register digitally that the procedure adopted is transparent, successful and provides more accountability so as to ensure that the subsidy amount reached the beneficiaries fully and with a view to know the number of beneficiaries with relevant details. He is also requested to send a monthly progress report in this regard regularly to Government without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.53767/Agri./11, dated 2.11.2011 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.766 (Seven Hundred and Sixty Six).
