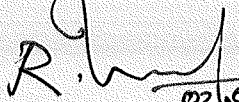

Annexure-I

Guidelines for implementation of the scheme of "Providing Electric Motor Pumpsets to Farmers with Subsidy"

I. Application canvassing, verification and registering process:

- Village level meetings, camps should be organized to explain the benefit of the scheme to the farmers besides advising the farmers to replace their old and inefficient electric motor pumpsets. Further, wide publicity shall be made through local press by distribution of pamphlets and by displaying about the implementation of the scheme in notice board of all village panchayats by the District Executive Engineers (AE).
- Farmer can apply either through online using the Micro Irrigation Management Information System (MIMIS) portal or by visiting the local subdivisions of Agricultural Engineering Department to make entries in the MIMIS portal.
- Applications in the portal will be scrutinized on priority basis and based on the technical suitability and seniority, the scheme assistance will be provided to the farmers.
- In case of farmers visiting the office to apply, the farmer shall be requested to submit an application in the prescribed format (form A) communicated to the concerned Assistant Executive Engineers (AE).
- The farmer has to indicate the make and model of the electric motor pumpsets of his/her choice from the approved and empanelled make and models list. The farmer has to give details in the application along with the proforma invoice obtained from the firm/dealer. The Assistant Executive Engineers(AE) should ensure that the applications are in the prescribed format containing all the relevant details such as Survey number, well ownership details, extent of land, Electric service connection number, Make, Model and HP of the existing pumpset, year of installation, make and model of the pumpsets to be replaced etc.
- The following records shall be obtained from the farmer along with the application and records should be maintained in the sub division level:-
 - a. Farmer ID generated in Farmer Registry should be documented
 - b. Chitta
 - c. Adangal
 - d. Service connection certificate-Photo copy
 - e. First page of bank pass book.- Photo copy
 - f. Community certificate - Photo copy (For SC/ST Farmers)

If all the documents coincide with the farmer's name, then necessary entries shall be made in the application register by the Assistant Engineer (AE)/Junior Engineer (AE).

II. Pre inspection

Based on the application received from the farmers, Assistant Engineer (AE) /Junior Engineer (AE) has to conduct pre- inspection in the farmers fields and verify the following:-

- a. Farmer name
- b. Service connection Number. (as per certificate if available)
- c. HP/Phase
- d. Make /Model/manufacture or dealer
- e. Energy index of the Electric motor pumpsets
- f. Whether Micro Irrigation System (MIS) already has been installed by the beneficiary farmer through Tamil Nadu Horticulture Development Agency (TANHODA)

Energy index (EI) of any pumpsets gives the unit consumed for lifting one lakh litres of water to one metre height in one hour. Pumpsets with energy index less than 0.75 are considered to be efficient pumpsets and hence the pumpsets with energy index of more than 0.75 alone should be considered for replacement.

Energy index is given by the formula.

$$E.I = 27.78kW/qh$$

where q=discharge in litres per sec

h=total static head in metres

kW=Input power

Based on the above, a recommendation certificate is to be given by the Assistant Engineer (AE) / Junior Engineer (AE) for the replacement of inefficient old pumpset and necessary entries are to be made in the Scheme register. At the time of pre inspection, photo should be taken by the Assistant Engineer (AE) / Junior Engineer (AE) in the field along with the farmer at the site.

III. Priority register

- The Assistant Executive Engineer (AE)s should maintain a priority register as per the format in Form-B.

IV. Issue of Supply order

According to the priority register, supply order should be given by the Assistant Executive Engineer (AE) to the farmers, after verifying the following records and documents:-

- Pre inspection report and photo

- In the case of replacement of old pumpsets or purchase of new pumpsets for the newly created wells, it should be ensured that the HP of the new electric motor pumpsets does not exceed the HP limit prescribed in the service connection certificate.
- The motor pumpsets to be replaced with the same phase as per the eligible service connection.
- The eligible farmer should hand over the Proforma invoice to the Assistant Executive Engineer (AE) concerned.
- Pumpsets proposed to be purchased by the farmer should only be from the manufacturers/dealers empanelled and approved by the Chief Engineer (AE) communicated by this office.
- The electric motor pumpsets proposed should necessarily be of energy efficient ISI (BIS) standard pumpsets, with minimum 4 star rating and with necessary warranty.
- The supply order is to be issued to the manufacturer/dealer by the Assistant Executive Engineer (AE)s concerned as per the proforma invoice handed over by the farmer. A copy of the supply order should be given to the farmer also.

V. Installation of pumpsets

- It should be ensured at the time of inspection by the Assistant Engineer (AE) / Junior Engineer (AE)s that the electric motor pumpset purchased by the farmer is as per the supply order issued by the Assistant Executive Engineer (AE)
- The farmers name in the invoice of the electric motor pumpset to be purchased should be the same as that of the proforma invoice.
- The invoice should contain the serial number of the electric motor pumpset.
- It should be ensured that the serial number should be engraved in the body of the electric motor pumpsets.
- The erection of electric motor pumpset should be carried out in the presence of Assistant Engineer (AE)/Junior Engineer (AE)s.
- Photo should be taken with the farmer at the site during execution.

VI. Release of backended Subsidy:

- Recommendation should be given by the Assistant Engineer (AE)/ Junior Engineer (AE)s based on the inspection carried out and as per the recommendation, the invoice shall be considered for payment of backended subsidy by the Agricultural Engineering Department.
- The Assistant Executive Engineer(AE) should verify that, whether the make and model of the electric motor pumpset has been approved by the Chief Engineer (AE).
- The Assistant Executive Engineer (AE) should also ensure that the invoice contains the serial number of the electric motor pumpset.
- Photos (both pre inspection and during execution) of the electric motor pumpsets along with farmer should be verified by the Assistant Executive Engineer (AE) before the release of subsidy.

- The Assistant Executive Engineer (AE) is competent to sanction the subsidy, draw the bills and pay the same into farmers account through ECS.

VII. General:

- The Chief Engineer (AE) Agricultural Engineering Department will empanel and approve the make and model of electric motor pumpsets, with minimum 4 star rating which alone will be eligible for subsidy.
- The farmer can negotiate with the manufacturer or dealer and reduce the total cost of electric motor pumpset approved by the Agricultural Engineering Department and if so, it should be informed to the Chief Engineer (AE)'s office. Based on the negotiated price, the subsidy shall be calculated and released to the farmer.
- The subsidy is to be released to the farmer and proper acknowledgement is to be obtained in the prescribed format and maintained.
- A scheme register with pre inspection details, work execution details and release of subsidy is to be maintained in the subdivision. (format enclosed)
- The beneficiary should execute a bond in stamp paper value of Rs.200/- stating that he/she will not dispose the new pumpset for another 3 (three) years from the date of its installation.
- A farmer is eligible for subsidy assistance for the purchase of only one number either for new pumpset for the new well or for replacement on the existing well eventhough he/she is having more than one well.
