ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have conveyed that a sum of Rs.5.33 lakh have been allocated as Central share for implementation of Crop Diversification Programme (CDP) under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana for replacing tobacco farming with alternate crops/cropping system during 2019-20 and requested to prepare intervention wise physical / financial targets and submit Annual Action Plan for the year 2019-20, including Central and State share.

2. In the Government letter 3rd read above, the Annual Action Plan for a sum of Rs.8.88 lakh (Government of India share Rs.5.33 lakh + State share Rs.3.55 lakh) has been forwarded to the Government of India.

3. In the letter 4th read above, it has been conveyed by the Government of India that Annual Action Plan for the year 2019-20 has been approved, subject to the approval of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC).

4. In the letter 5th read above, the Government of India have released an amount of Rs.2.67 lakh as 1st instalment of Government of India share for implementation of Crop Diversification Programme (CDP) under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana for replacing tobacco farming with alternate crops/cropping system during 2019-20.

5. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, in the letter 5th read above, has requested financial sanction for an amount of Rs.4.44 lakh (Government of India Share Rs.2.67 lakh + State Share Rs.1.77 lakh) as 1st first instalment for the project "Crop Diversification Programme", under National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana for "replacing Tobacco farming with alternate crops / cropping system", a Sub scheme under National Agriculture Development Programme 2019-20 to the department of Horticulture for implementation of the scheme.

6. In the letter 6th read above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has recommended the proposal of the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops and requested to administrative sanction for the entire amount of Rs.8.88 lakh approved by the Government of India and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.4.44 lakh as 1st instalment to the following component:-

7. After examination of the proposals of the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops and the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency, the Government have decided to accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.8.88 lakh and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.4.44 lakh (Rupees Four lakh and forty four thousand only) as 1st instalment in the funding pattern of 60:40 between the Central and State Governments i.e. Government of India share Rs.2.67 lakh and State share Rs.1.77 lakh towards implementation of Crop Diversification Programme, a sub scheme under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana during 2019-20, subject to the condition that necessary ratification has to be obtained in the ensuing State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC).

8. The Component details and the heads of account to which the expenditure sanctioned in para.7 above shall be debited are mentioned in the annexure to this order.

9. Necessary additional funds will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-20 under the relevant heads of account. Pending

provision of such funds, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 7 above to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Horticulture Development Agency by relaxing quarterly control of appropriation. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposal for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-20 to Government in Finance (Agri) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

10. The Director of Horticulture & Plantation Crops is directed to fix the Physical target based on the need and potential of the districts.

11. The Director of Horticulture & Plantation Crops is directed to follow the RKVY – RAFTAAR guidelines and furnish the monthly report to the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for onward transmission to Government of India.

12. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.43058/Agri/2019, Dated: 20.09.2019 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1495 (One thousand four hundred and ninety five).
