## ORDER:

National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana is an important Centrally Sponsored flagship Programme implemented with an aim to make farming a remunerative economic activity through strengthening farmers' efforts, risk mitigation and promoting agri business entrepreneurship. National Agriculture Development Programme is being implemented in the State since the year 2007-08 through 15 implementing departments pertaining to agriculture and allied sectors. Project proposals under National Agriculture Development Programme (60:40 sharing basis) are put forth before the State Level Sanctioning Committee chaired by the Chief Secretary to Government for approval.

2. Accordingly, in the letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above, the 19<sup>th</sup> State Level Sanctioning Committee in its meeting held on 21.4.2021, has approved 74 project proposals worth Rs.361.485 crore on priority and 27 projects worth Rs.77.142 crore under shelf of projects and 3 projects worth Rs.4.532 crore from earlier shelf of projects totalling Rs.443.15 crore under National Agriculture Development Programme for the year 2021-22.

- 3. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Government of India have allocated a sum of Rs.190.93 Crore as Central Share for the year 2021-22 for National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana in the funding pattern of 60:40 sharing between Central and the State Governments. By adding the corresponding 40% State share of Rs.127.29 crore, the total allocation is worked out as Rs.318.22 crore.
- 4. In the Government Order 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, the Government have accorded administrative approval for the 74 projects including the projects of Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops for an outlay of Rs.304.09 crore as downsized and recommended by Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency under National Agriculture Development Programme during 2021-22 in tune with the allocation made by Government of India. It has been stated that the financial Sanction will be issued separately as and when funds are released by Government of India.
- 5. In the letters 4<sup>th</sup> read above, the Government of India have released a sum of Rs.92.92 crore [Rs.90.18 crore for Normal National Agriculture Development Programme (General Rs.72.58 Crore) + (SCSP Rs.17.28 Crore) + (TSP Rs.0.32 Crore) as 1<sup>st</sup> instalment for the year 2021-2022 & Rs.2.74 crore for two sub schemes under National Agriculture Development Programme]. By adding the 40% State share of Rs.60.12 crore for Normal National Agriculture Development Programme, the total release for 1<sup>st</sup> instalment is worked out as Rs.150.30 crore.
- 6. For the first time in the History of Tamil Nadu, the Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare has presented a separate Budget for Agriculture on the floor of Legislative Assembly on 14.08.2021 and among others the following announcements relating to the Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops have been made:-

#### **Announcement No.3**

## Organic Farming Development Scheme

The Farmers who adopt organic farming will be encouraged with provision of inputs subsidy.

#### **Announcement No.7**

## Palmyra Development Mission

Action will be taken to distribute one lakh palmyra seedlings to farmers during the year.

## **Announcement No.28**

#### Promotion of fruit cultivation for fruitful income

At National Level, Tamil Nadu stands seventh in production and eleventh in area under fruit crops. The present area of 3.13 lakh hectare under the cultivation of fruits will be increased to 3.30 lakh hectare during this year. The required planting materials of 80 lakh fruit plants will be produced in State horticulture Farms and distributed to farmers.

## **Announcement No.29**

## Chief Minister's Nutritive Vegetable Garden Scheme

An area of 1,250 Ha in 2000 villages where the vegetable cultivation is meager will be brought under vegetable cultivation by enhancing the soil fertility. Pandal structure will be promoted in an area of 638 Ha for cultivation of gourds and greens in an area of 1000 Ha in all districts.

## **Announcement No.31**

### Focus on Prime Horticulture Districts

Horticulture Godown will be constructed in the districts where horticultural crops are predominantly grown. Emphasis will be given for cultivation of Horticultural crops such as Greens and Chillies in Thiruvallur district, Cashew and Jack in Cuddalore district, Pepper and Onion in Namakkal district, Acid lime and Amla in Tenkasi district. These districts will be provided with support and service right from sowing to marketing of the produce.

7. Based on the Government of India release, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, has sent the prioritized and recommended project proposals by Executive Director Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for financial sanction for a sum of Rs.25.9613 crore under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2021-2022 as 1<sup>st</sup> instalment for implementation of the following projects by including the announcements made by the Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare:-

- 8. Diversification to horticulture crops not only increases the farmers' income but also improves the nutritional security of the population. Assistance for Organic Cultivation of vegetables, cultivation of choice horticulture crops, new varieties and Pandal cultivation will encourage farmers to readily take up these activities.
- 9. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, hereby accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.25.9613 Crore (Rupees Twenty five Crore Ninety Six Lakh and Thirteen thousand only) as 1<sup>st</sup> instalment for implementation of the PP.Nos.19.13, 19.14, 19.15, 19.17 and 19.18 to the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, under National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana for the year 2021-22 as the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment release subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing basis between the Central and State Governments.
- 10. The amount sanctioned in the para.9 above shall be debited to the Heads of account annexed to this order.
- 11. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to draw the fund sanctioned and permit him to transfer the funds to the Single Nodal Account as per the new procedure of fund flow through Public Financial Management System (PFMS) issued by Government of India for implementing the projects.
- 12. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is permitted to fix the physical target based on the need and potential of the districts. Necessary relaxation of quarterly funds is given to the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops for the effective implementation of the schemes in time.
- 13. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to implement the announcements made by the Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare during Budget Session for the year 2021-2022 scrupulously.

- 14. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.
- 15. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the projects.
- 16. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to follow the respective Operational Guidelines and Executive Guidelines annexed to this order and the conditions stipulated at para.8 of the Government of India letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above while implementing the schemes.
- 17. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.
- 18. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.

In the letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above the State Level Sanctioning Committee of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana has approved in its 19<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 21.04.2021 for preparing the Annual Action Plan under Sub Schemes as per the allocation to be made by Government of India for the year 2021-22 and to implement the Sub scheme. (Other Subjects for approval 19.0.5)

2. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Government of India has allocated an amount of Rs.5.40 Crore as Central share for the implementation of Area expansion of Cashew, a sub-scheme under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme in Tamil Nadu during the year 2021-22.

- 3. In the Government letter 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, the Annual Action Plan for an amount 9.00 crore (Central share Rs.5.40 crore + State share Rs.3.60 crore) for the year 2021-22 was sent to the Government of India for approval and allocation of funds for implementation of Area Expansion of Cashew (AEC) under National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana during 2021-22.
- 3. In the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, the Government of India has released Rs.2.70 Crore as the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment to the State for implementation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "Area Expansion of Cashew" a sub-scheme of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2021-22. By adding corresponding State share of Rs.1.80 crore, the total (first instalment) allocation is worked out to Rs.4.50 crore.
- 4. Based on the above release of funds, in the letter 5<sup>th</sup> read above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has recommended the proposal of the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, requesting administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.9.00 crore and financial sanction for an amount of Rs.4.50 crore (Government of India Share Rs.2.70 crore + State Share Rs.1.80 crore) as 1<sup>st</sup> first instalment for the implementation of "Area Expansion of Cashew High density planting and Normal planting" under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana during the year 2021-22 in all the districts of Tamil Nadu except Chennai and The Nilgris as given below:-

- 5. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, in his letter 6<sup>th</sup> read above, has requested to accord administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.13.33 lakh and financial sanction for an amount of Rs.6.67 lakh (Government of India Share Rs.4.00 lakh + State Share Rs.2.67 lakh) as 1<sup>st</sup> first instalment for the project "Crop Diversification Programme for "replacing Tobacco farming with alternate crops / cropping system", a Sub scheme under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2021-22 to the Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops for implementation of the scheme.
